

How does someone become a Foundation Fellow?

To become an initial **Foundation Fellow**, contribute \$250 (in one payment, or in partial payments of \$50) to the Darien Lions Foundation and include this form.

Subsequent “progressive” **Foundation Fellows are \$250** each.

What does the Foundation Fellow receive?

For every \$250 contribution, the person named as a Foundation Fellow will receive a framed certificate. The person’s name will also be permanently embroidered on the Darien Lions Foundation Banner of Honor that will be displayed at all Darien Lions Club meetings and appropriate functions. Subsequent “progressive” contribution levels will be honored as follows: after the 3rd contribution - “**Bronze Fellow**”; after the 6th contribution - “**Silver Fellow**”; after the 10th contribution - “**Gold Fellow**”; after the 15th contribution - “**Platinum Fellow**”; and after the 20th contribution - “**Diamond Fellow**”. Framed certificates will be given to the person named and his or her named will be permanently embroidered on the Darien Lions Foundation Banner of Honor with the higher contribution level designation.
